Phonics Phonics is the understanding that there is a predictable relationship between phonemes (the sounds of spoken language) and graphemes (the letters and spellings that represent those sounds in written language) Phonemic awareness Phonemic awareness is the ability to hear, identify, and manipulate the individual sounds—phonemes—in spoken
