adv 01: adverbs of time, frequency, quantity, intensity

Adverbs provide information about how, where, when, to what degree, or how often an action takes place They modify verbs or adjectives or other adverbs An adverb expresses things like time, frequency, manner, place, quantity, or intensity Adverbs are placed close to the word they modify (the verb, the adjective or the other adverb)
